- The Vision Center on Spencer was visited and it appears they are in compliance. They have 74 spaces and three accessible parking spaces. Two are in the front, the van accessible space is on the east side of the building by a door.
- A letter will be sent out to Vision Source on Northland as they have 29 spaces but only one handicapped space and no van accessible signage. John and Joe Ok'd the letter as is.
- John will order new "Van Accessible" signage as the current inventory is at 10 (John has 3 signs and Jill has 7). Once we are billed we will have SOAR issue a check for payment.
- The ramp by the PAC will be checked by John and Jane and we will discuss at the January meeting.
- Jill will send out language for the post-it notes we plan to print educating people about the proper use of access aisles. Each member could then use these post-it notes when they see issues in the community. Joe may have a printer contact we can use.
- Amy will double check the Northland Avenue Bar to determine if they have become compliant after receiving a letter from this committee. Jill will send her the letter that went out.
- Joe suggested we send another letter to Dick and Joan's and copy the Town of Grand Chute Chairperson and the building inspector. Jill will check if any changes have been made and then mail the letter.
- Bob will check out new Aldi's on Richmond and the new Veteran's Village and report back in January.
- Next meeting of the committee will be **Tuesday, January 12** at 10:30am via Zoom. A link will be sent out a couple days ahead of time.
