- Both Jill and John spoke with Allyn Dannhoff from the Village of Kimberly regarding Liberty Hall. He was interested in being helpful and planned to have an inspector talk with the business. His plan was to connect back with our group once the inspector made a visit. Jill will let everyone know the result of this when he lets us know.
- Jill will talk with Joe Martin to determine if he has a connection with the Grand Chute Building inspector to address the accessibility issues at Dick and Joan's. If Grand Chute is not willing to assist our group, will file a complaint.
- Discussed two locations (Theda Care Behavioral Health and business at 3212 E. Calumet) and how to count their spaces to determine if they have adequate spaces. Will check with the ADA technical assistance center to clarify the rule that applies to this. Behavioral Health has an employee entrance but clients also use this entrance? Spots in front lacking access aisles but are these spaces necessary to meet the requirements?
- Building in the strip mall housing a laundromat and Pho House off of Richmond Street does not have any accessible parking. Request Joe get owner's name to send letter.
- New business checks:
